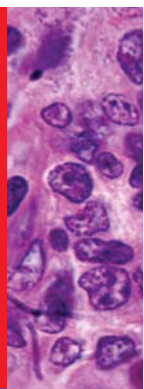
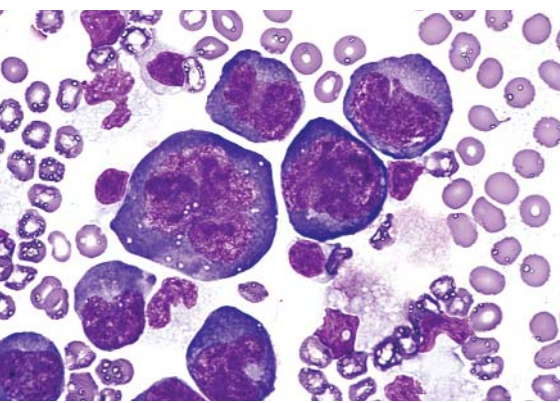

Course Goals & Objectives

This course is designed to update physicians on the latest advances in Neoplastic Hematopathology. It will be conducted under the direction of Dr. Daniel M. Knowles at the Marco Island Marriott Resort, Golf Club & Spa on Marco Island, Florida from January 23-27, 2012. The program will consist of lectures, case presentations and discussions designed to provide pathologists, pathologists-in-training and medical oncologists/hematologists with an in-depth discussion of diagnostic problems that arise in neoplastic hematopathology. In addition to discussions of recent advances in the morphologic classification of hematopoietic tumors, the application and interpretation of immunological and cytochemical studies and molecular techniques in the diagnosis and classification of these diseases will be presented.

An extensive USB flash drive comprised of lecture notes and reference citations covering all of the topics presented at the Tutorial along with a notebook comprised of all powerpoint presentations, will be prepared. The Tutorial notebook and flash drive will be distributed to you when you register at the Tutorial in Florida.
