**Course Goals & Objectives**

This course is designed to update physicians on the latest advances in Neoplastic Hematopathology. It will be conducted under the direction of Dr. Daniel M. Knowles at the Marco Island Resort, Spa and Golf Course on Marco Island, Florida from January 24-January 29, 2010. The program will consist of lectures, case presentations and discussions designed to provide pathologists, pathologists-in-training and medical oncologists/hematologists with an in-depth discussion of diagnostic problems that arise in neoplastic hematopathology. In addition to discussions of recent advances in the morphologic classification of hematopoietic tumors, the application and interpretation of immunological and cytochemical studies and molecular techniques in the diagnosis and classification of these diseases will be presented.

An extensive CD-ROM comprised of lecture notes and reference citations covering all of the topics presented at the Tutorial along with a notebook comprised of all powerpoint presentations, will be prepared. The Tutorial notebook and CD-ROM will be distributed to you when you register at the Tutorial in Florida.

Pathologists, pathologists-in-training and medical oncologists/hematologists. Note: No video or audio recording will be allowed.
